



Rules & Regulations

The Columbaria known as St. Anne and St. Hilda at St. Anastasia Catholic Church are available for inurnment of the cremated human remains (cremains) of any baptized Catholic, their spouse, dependents and relatives or dependents and relatives of their spouse.

A removable container (vault) will be required for each niche, which will be a receptacle for the cremains and purchased at time of inurnment. No other types of urns will be used. Cremains shall be provided to St. Anastasia Catholic Church.

Niches are available for purchase as a companion niche for up to two individual cremains or for one individual cremains.

Due to space limitations no jewelry, memorabilia, etc. may be placed in the container with the cremains.

At the time of inurnment and after the appropriate inscription fee has been paid, an engraved inscription will be provided showing the name of the person whose cremains are inurned with the years of birth and death. All inscriptions will conform to a standard determined by the Church.

No transfer or assignment of niche (s) may be made without the written consent of the Pastor of St. Anastasia Catholic Church.

St. Anastasia Catholic Church will endeavor to protect the cremains but can assume no responsibility other than to afford them the same protection as it provides its other property.

The subscription cost for the niche must be paid in full before any cremains may be inurned within. The Pastor of St. Anastasia Catholic Church reserves the right to modify these rules and regulations at any time.
